Registration

To be published in the IEEE DySPAN 2017 Conference Proceedings and IEEE Xplore®, an author of an accepted paper is required to register for the conference at the non-student rate (member or non-member) and the paper must be presented at the conference. Non-refundable registration fees must be paid prior to uploading the final IEEE formatted, publication-ready version of the paper. For authors with multiple accepted papers, one full registration is valid for up to 3 papers. Accepted papers will be published in the IEEE DySPAN 2017 Conference Proceedings. Accepted and presented papers will be published in the IEEE DySPAN 2017 Conference Proceedings and in IEEE Xplore®.

PLEASE NOTE: To be published in the IEEE DySPAN 2017 Conference Proceedings and IEEE Xplore®, an author of an accepted paper is required to register for the conference at the full (member or non-member) rate and the paper must be presented by an author of that paper at the conference unless the TPC Chair grants permission for a substitute presenter arranged in advance of the event and who is qualified both to present and answer questions. Non-refundable registration fees must be paid prior to uploading the final IEEE formatted, publication-ready version of the paper. For authors with multiple accepted papers, one full registration is valid for up to 3 papers. Accepted and presented papers will be published in the IEEE DySPAN 2017 Conference Proceedings and submitted to IEEE Xplore®.
